

Calhoun, Georgia
January 9, 1961

City Council met in regular session at the city hall with all members present.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Rev. Otto Kay, Pastor of First Presbyterian Church .

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Clerk and approved by the Council.

A delegation of Calhoun Jaycees were present at the request of Alderman Tom David to discuss the proposed city limit extension. Mr. David stated that the discussion he had had with various persons about the extension would include the following city limit lines: Out the Red Bud Road East to the proposed Route # 75, thence South to Route # 53, thence West along route #53 to U.S. #41, thence, follow the Jess Johnson farm line to the Oothcalooga Creek and then follow the Creek to the River. After a lengthy discussion about the problems that must be faced, Mayor Edwards stated that he would see what could be worked out about the power in the proposed section and see what other towns were doing with similar situations.

A pot of flowers were sent to the Mayor, Council and Clerk expressing good wishes for the coming year and appreciation for the job done in the past by Mr. S.M. Harrison.

Fire truck answering calls outside city limits was discussed by the council. Alderman David made a motion that the fire truck be permitted to answer calls to manufacturing plants outside city limits with 10 or more employees. There was no second to the motion and Mayor Edwards declared it no motion.

Mayor Edwards appointed all the committees the same for the year 1961 as 1960.

Council appointed Mr. John Gregory, City Attorney for the year 1961.

Alderman Billy Norton made a motion that Alderman Frank Dickinson be appointed Mayor Pro Tem for the year 1961. This motion received a second from Alderman Tom David was voted on and passed.

Alderman Tom David made a motion that all department heads be re-appointed for another year at the present salaries. These being:
James Owens ---Supt.
Crofford Hayes----Police Chief
Bill Champion---- Fire Chief
Harold Kirby----- Street Supt.
Calvin Caldwell---Clerk and Treas.


City Superintendent James Owens stated to the council that the city needs a vehicle for the meter reader. Stated that he had bids from Owens-Prater Ford and Davis Brothers Chevrolet for a new Pickup. Stated that he planned to use the new truck in the electric department and use the 1953 Chevrolet for the meter reader. The bids were as follows: \$1661.98 Davis Brothers Chev., \$1625.00 was Owens-Prater Ford bid. Alderman Dickinson made a motion that the city purchase the Ford from Owens-Prater Ford. This motion was seconded by Alderman Norton voted on and passed.

Council raised pay of meter reader Rex Prater from \$1.25 per hour to \$1.38 per hour. Motion made by David seconded by Dickinson voted on and passed.

City Council issued the following Beer License for the year 1961. American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Smitty's Beverage Store, Troy's Grill, Sim Sutherland.

Alderman Dickinson made a motion that the Special License Ordinance for the year 1961 be the same as used in 1960 and be adopted this date. Second by David voted on and passed.
