City Council met in regular session at the city hall with all members present.

Alderman Frank M. Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Clerk and approved by the council.

A delegation from the Calhoun Grammar School P.T.A. was present and presented the council with a petition calling for the widening and building a sidewalk on Pitts Street from East Line Street to Fain Street. The petition stated this was necessary for the safety of the school children attending the grammar school. After discussing the matter the council instructed the city superintendent to get the cost figures for the widening and a sidewalk and have these figures at the next meeting and they would act on the matter at said meeting.

Alderman David made a motion that all employees of the city paid by the hour be given a \$30.00 bonus for Christmas, all employees paid by the month be given \$50.00, and all department heads be given one fourth of their monthly salary. This motion was seconded by alderman Woods voted on and passed. It was also decided to include the sick leave pay in the same check.

The following results on the city limit extension vote were given to the council by the clerk:

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
