

1. Mayor Palmer called the meeting to order.
2. Mayor's Comments:
 - a. Mayor Palmer asked for a motion to declare the City of Calhoun a disaster area as a result of the May 1, 2002 storm. Councilman Woods made a motion to declare the City of Calhoun a disaster area, second by Mayor Pro Tem Shelton, with Councilman Woods, Mayor Pro Tem Shelton, Councilman Denmon and Councilwoman Potts voting affirmatively, motion carried.
 - b. Mayor Palmer stated the city needs to proceed with bids for removal of storm debris under emergency purchasing policies and to authorize improvements of damaged public property to be restored under emergency purchasing policies. Councilman Woods made a motion to approve, second by Councilman Denmon, with Councilman Woods, Councilman Denmon, Councilwoman Potts and Mayor Pro Tem Shelton voting affirmatively, motion carried.
