

FEB. 22, 1971 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Mr. J. C. Boyd, Executive Director of the Calhoun Housing Authority, asked Council to approve the application for 200 housing units for the elderly. Approval given on motion of Ald. David, 2nd of Ald. Cox.
3. Ald. Padgett offered a motion to prohibit parking on both sides of Piedmont St. from Hicks St. south to its intersection with S. Wall St., 2nd by Ald. David, voted on and passed.
4. Council discussed cutting trees at SE corner of N. Piedmont and Trammell Sts. Ald. David said he would like to talk with Miss Alda Bolding before taking any action on this.
5. Ald. Holland reported that the State Health Dept. will not approve the water from Roe Springs.
6. Ald. Cox moved that the streets at the entrance to the Gordon Hills Shopping Center be marked as recommended by the State Highway Dept. Ald. Padgett seconded and the motion was approved.
7. Ald. Cox advised that the police department wished to jointly (with Gordon County) employ a detective to work with the police and the Sheriff's department. Council approved.
8. Bids were opened on a new patrol car for the police department with Roy Davis Chev-Olds - \$3,525.00, Prater Ford - \$3,397.00 and Lee Suggs Chrysler-Plymouth - \$3,464.90. Ald. Cox moved that the low bid (Prater Ford) be accepted, 2nd by Ald. Holland and done.
9. Mr. J. C. Boyd advised that there were several stray dogs roaming the project area.
10. Elec. Supt. Jack Bell reported the power would be off on Sunday, Feb. 28 for about two hours.
11. Ald. David suggested policemen patrol more frequently in residential neighborhoods particularly where women live alone.
12. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and done.
