

JAN. 11, 1971 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Ronald F. Chance acted as chaplain in the absence of Dr. T. J. Lance and opened the meeting with the reading of "The Beatitudes", (Mathew-5:1-19).
2. Minutes of the regular meeting of Dec. 28 read and approved.
3. Mayor Dickinson administered the oath of office to newly elected Ald. Billy K. Padgett and re-elected Ald. Tom B. David.
4. All department heads were reappointed on motion of Ald. David and second of Ald. Cox.
5. Ald. David named mayor pro tempore following motion of Ald. Holland and second of Ald. Cox.
6. Tom Shanahan reappointed city attorney on motion of Ald. David and second of Ald. Padgett.
7. Dr. T. J. Lance re-named chaplain by the Council.
8. Ald. Holland moved that city employees be given a cost of living salary increase in the amount of 10%, retroactive to Jan. 1, 1971. Ald. Cox 2nd and the motion was unanimously approved.
9. The Calhoun First National Bank was named official depository of the city on motion of Ald. Holland and second of Ald. Cox.
10. Ald. Holland moved that Bruce Bowman become head of the water and sewer departments; 2nd by Ald. Cox, voted on and passed.
11. Mayor Dickinson said Ald. Padgett will chair the same committees as former Ald. Woods except streets and sanitation formerly under Ald. Holland, now to be chaired by Mr. Padgett with Mr. Holland taking water and lights. All other appointments remain the same as in 1970.
12. Council gave John T. Woods, Jr. a two grave plot in Fain Cemetery in appreciation of his more than 16 years service to the city as an alderman.
13. Ald. Holland said he had no recommendations as yet as to left turns from Piedmont into Line St.
14. Council, at the request of Ald. David, agreed to ask Rep. Shanahan to introduce legislation creating an airport authority.
15. Supt. Owens heard in regard to the contract with Mrs. John Roe for water from the springs on her property. Mayor Dickinson advised this be delayed until Jan. 25 meeting.
16. Council discussed at length the prospect of obtaining water from Dew's Springs and the city's water situation in general.
17. Elec. Supt. Bell stated that the line truck quoted by Stith Equip - ment was not satisfactory and recommended purchase of Altec's body. Council approved following motion of Ald. Holland and 2nd of Ald. Cox. (Purchase price - \$19,069.00.)
18. Asst. Supt. Fox reported that Modern Maid homes was expecting to have city sewer service around April 1.
19. Mayor Dickinson announced that the Gordon Co C of C had asked the city to increase its annual payment to the chamber from \$250.00 to \$1,000.00.
20. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Holland and done.
