

SEPT. 27, 1971 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Sept. 13 meeting read and approved.
3. John Slagle and John Cunningham said they had a shopping center and two motels interested in locating on their property south side of SR 53 between US 41 and I-75, but they needed sanitary sewer service. The matter was discussed, but no action taken.
4. Tommy Langston and Leon Brown asked Council approval for the promotion of wrestling matches in the Sutherland building at N. Wall and Nelson Sts. Council advised that action would be taken at the Oct. 11 meeting.
5. Mayor Dickinson, with approval of the Board of Aldermen, appointed Robert L. Collins, Jr., John T. Woods, Jr. and Hoyt Edwards as the Old Fain Cemetery Committee.
6. Ald. Cox reported that the ban on night parking in the Gordon Hills Shopping Center was very effective last weekend.
7. Ald. Holland advised that he had met with Robert L. Collins, Jr., trust officer of the Calhoun First National Bank and will meet with the department heads soon to discuss the retirement plans.
8. Ald. Holland offered a motion to proceed with the installation of some \$6,000.00 worth of capacitors to improve the electrical system; 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.
9. Ald. Holland moved that no deposit be required of industries with approved credit ratings with others depositing, in cash or bond, two months estimated consumption, with this amount to be refunded after seven years. Ald. Cox seconded the motion and it was voted on and passed.
10. Ald. Padgett moved to grant John H. Bell a package beer license for Troy's Package Shop at 344 S. Wall St., seconded by Ald. Cox and unanimously approved.
11. Johnny Brown and Melvin Greeson were told that the city cannot serve water to their two story apartment house in Conasauga Hts.
12. Supt. Owens heard in regard to furnishing sanitary sewer service to a proposed Tourist Information Center north of the city. No action taken.
13. Supt. Owens recommended the purchase of a new cab & chassis for the Sanitation Dept. and Council authorized acceptance of bids.
14. Ald. Holland moved to accept two parcels of property of Kenneth Fuqea for annexation, one on Dan Cheri Drive and one on Peters St.; 2nd by Ald. Cox, voted on and passed.
15. Asst. Supt. Fox said the landfill operator was having difficulty getting some drivers to unload and leave in the allotted time. Council advised to have the caretaker deputized.
16. Council discussed the water situation and agreed that shortage is critical in Conasauga Hts. and Fite Bend east of Resaca and reaching this stage beyond Antioch Church.
17. Ald. Padgett moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. David and done.
