

AUG. 9, 1971 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT EX-
CEPT ALDERMAN HOLLAND.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the July 26 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Cox said that left turns from Park Ave. into Line St. should be prohibited. Ald. Padgett moved that this be done, 2nd by Ald. Cox and passed.
4. Ald. Padgett commended Chief Hayes and the police department for controlling the unruly conduct that has prevailed on week-ends in the Gordon Hills Shopping Center.
5. Council appointed Robert L. Collins, Jr. to membership on the airport authority to serve with Chairman Tom David and J. C. Maddox.
6. Asst. Supt. Fox reported that Master Engineering & Construction Co. had nearly completed the sewer line and Indian River Const. was approaching the half-way mark on the sewage treatment plant.
7. Ald. Padgett moved that up to 5 parking meters may be removed for a driveway to the new Calhoun Federal Building on S. Wall. Ald. Cox seconded and the motion was voted on and passed.
8. The recreation commission was represented by Chairman Edna Langford, Commissioners Buford Chitwood, Farrell Palmer, Atkins Henderson, Tom David and Director Bill Bearden. Mrs. Langford briefed the Council on a proposed increase in their budget to \$50,000.00 annually and requested an additional \$10,000.00 a year from the city. Council asked a delay in making a definite commitment until a joint meeting with Comm. DeFoor can be held.
9. Council authorized publication of an ad notifying contractors and others that they will be required to pay for damages to sidewalks, curb and gutter and any and all public property destroyed or damaged as well as keeping the sidewalks and streets cleaned off.
10. Ald. David moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Cox and done.
