

NOV. 22, 1971 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Nov. 8 meeting read and approved.
3. The request of Mrs. Bill Mathews that the space now used for the Roland Hayes Day Nursery be retained for this purpose was ordered by Mayor Dickinson to be entered on the official record.
4. Ald. David reported that the City Board of Education wants the city to purchase the property adjacent to the East Side Elementary School that borders on Barrett Road and parallels Red Bud Road.
5. Ald. David said he had talked with Bill Sanders of Sanders and Associates of Atlanta with reference to federal aid programs. Ald. Holland explained that no fee is involved until a program is funded and recommended further study. Ald. Padgett then moved to invite Mr. Sanders to attend a council meeting; 2nd by Ald. Cox and passed.
6. Ald. David moved to grant city employees the same Christmas bonus as in 1970, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and passed.
7. Ald. Padgett made a motion to replace the 3 parking meters that were removed from the southwest corner of S. Court St. Ald. Cox 2nd and the motion was approved.
8. Ald. Cox stated that the meters removed during construction of Calhoun Federal should be replaced.
9. Ald. Padgett heard in regard to lighting at the park. Asst. Supt. Fox to look into this matter.
10. Ald. Cox advised that our radio service man has recommended the purchase of a new antenna and coaxial cable to improve reception on our two-way radios and Mr. Cox moved that this be done, 2nd by Ald. Holland and passed.
11. Ald. Holland reported on the meeting with "Robin" Collins and the department heads to discuss a retirement plan. Mr. Holland said that with information gleaned from the meeting, Mr. Collins has agreed to present revised plans in the near future.
12. Council approved all water taps recommended by the committee on motion of Ald. Holland and Cox.
13. Asst. Supt. Fox said he had a bid of \$250 for re-roofing and repairing the chapel at Chandler Cemetery. Council suggested he get one other bid.
14. Mr. Fox advised that it will cost \$225 to repair the sidewalk in front of the fire station. Ald. Holland moved to proceed with this work, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.
15. Mr. Fox said the cost of extending water to Quality Finishers will be about \$700. Council agreed to proceed following motion of Ald. Holland and Cox.
16. Ald. Padgett moved to accept the streets in Modern Maid's Valley Estates S/D; 2nd by Ald. David, voted on and passed.
17. Clerk read letter from Dick Carr, Chairman of the City Board of Education, requesting Council to give every consideration to the purchase of the aforementioned property at East Side Elementary.
18. Property of Quality Finishers and N & L, Inc. (Herbcraft) annexed to the city by petition of owners following motion of Ald. Holland and Cox.
19. Ald. David moved to close City Hall on Friday, Nov. 26, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, voted on and passed.


20. Water & Sewer Supt. Bowman reported that 400 water taps have been sold to date this year.
