

NOV. 8, 1971 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.


1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Oct. 25 meeting read and approved.
3. Charles Carson, owner of A & W Root Beer Drive In, asked when sanitary sewer service will be available at his N. Wall St. location. Council could give no definite answer, but advised Mr. Carson that this service will be extended as soon as possible.
4. Ald. Holland moved that water taps approved by the committee be made as they are paid for. Ald. Cox 2nd and the motion was passed.
5. Ald. Cox said it was OK to use the '69 Ford that Supt. Owens has been driving for a police car and moved to purchase 3 radios at a special price. Ald. Padgett seconded and the motion was voted on and passed.
6. Ald. Padgett suggested that additional parking space be made available immediately east of the city hall to alleviate double parking on S. Court St. Chief Hayes to contact Comm. Defoor and Sheriff Davis about this.
7. Ald. Padgett and Cox moved that the street between Prater Ford and Fair's Gulf Service be hereafter known as E. Richards St. The motion was adopted by unanimous vote.
8. Clerk read a letter from A. R. McDaniel, Jr. re the property at the SE intersection of W. Line and River Sts.
9. Council approved, on recommendation of Wiedeman & Singleton, the request of Indian River Construction that no additional retainage be charged on the sewage treatment plant.
10. Council accepted the property of Dr. Joseph A. Bishop known as Cherokee Nursing Home for annexation by petition following a motion by Ald. Cox, 2nd by Ald. Holland.
11. Bids opened on a cab and chassis for the Sanitation Dept. with Roy Davis Chevrolet-Olds-\$6,449.00 and Prater Ford-\$5,589.00. Ald. Cox moved to purchase the Ford, 2nd by Ald. Holland and passed.
12. Asst. Supt. Fox heard in regard to dogs overturning garbage cans at Cam Lan Apts.
13. Supt. Fox also reported that the sidewalk in front of the fire hall is in need of repair.
14. Ald. Cox said he had received complaints that a contractor had left a considerable amount of dirt on the sidewalk on S. Wall St.
15. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and done.
