

OCT. 11, 1971 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Sept. 27 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Cox moved to grant "Young Atlas" a license for wrestling performances on a weekly basis at Mrs. Sim Sutherland's building at N. Wall and Nelson Sts. and Tommy Langston a weekly license for the Bruce Bldg. on Park Ave. provided Ald. Cox and Chief Hayes approve the parking and lighting at the two locations. 2nd by Ald. Padgett and approved.
4. Milton Stewart, Dean Hayes and Dwight Walraven asked for sanitary sewer service to a 200-acre tract adjacent to Spring Valley S/D. Ald. Holland moved to proceed with the installation of the sewer if petitioners agree to cost and advance the money with the rebate to be determined later; 2nd by Ald. David and passed.
5. L. M. Lovinggood, Jr. present with reference to annexation of his property and others nearby. Asst. Supt. Fox estimated it will cost \$25,000 to serve all with sanitary sewer service or \$3,000 to serve Mr. Lovinggood alone. Mayor Dickinson ordered action deferred until October 25 meeting.
6. Ald. Cox heard in the matter of Gennelle Van Buskirk's property at 441 S. Wall St. Bldg. Insp. Roberts to determine if this house is unfit for human habitation.
7. Ald. David announced that Oct. 25-31 is Sequoyah Sesquicentennial Week with several activities planned in commemoration thereof.
8. Asst. Supt. Fox said the CD EOC at the new sewage treatment plant will cost an additional \$1,983.00. Ald. David moved that the city proceed with this, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.

19. Ald. Cox moved to change the business license ordinance on life insurance companies to require them to pay 1% of premium income; 2nd by Ald. Padgett, voted on and passed.
10. Water Supt. Bowman stated that Buford Chitwood's plant at Resaca operated 12 hours per day last week and will operate 16 hours per day this week. Council then discussed the possibility of installing a pump in the Resaca line to permit Mr. Chitwood to operate around the clock.
11. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Holland and done.
