



FEB. 8, 1971 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance gave the devotional with the reading of the 5th Psalm and prayer.
2. Minutes of the Jan. 25 meeting read and approved.
3. Representatives of American Legion Post 555 present at the request of Chief Hayes. The chief explained that the post was open after closing hours during a dance. Mayor Dickinson advised that the post could remain open until midnight on dance nights, but the guests should be restricted to members and out of county guests.
4. Mayor Dickinson requested Tom Bigley, urban renewal consultant, to answer a question from one of the Legionnaires with reference to federal aid for a community center. Mr. Bigley told of the programs available and left application forms. Mr. Bigley further explained his services including a code enforcement program in which the federal government pays 75% of costs.
5. Ald. Cox moved that George Hayes be appointed chief of police replacing Luther Roberts, resigned. Ald. Padgett seconded the motion and it was voted on and approved.
6. Mayor Dickinson read Chief Luther Roberts' letter of resignation effective March 1, 1971. It was accepted following motion of Ald. Cox and Padgett.
7. Ald. Cox stated that he approved the location and application of E. W. "Buck" Prather for a package malt beverage license in Gordon Hills Shopping Center. Mr. Cox moved the granting of the license, Ald. David seconded and the motion was passed.
8. Ald. Cox said Carl McEntire, Northwest Georgia Wrestlers, had asked permission to hold matches in the Ralston Building on the Rome Road each Friday evening and Mr. Cox proposed that he be allowed to pay \$10 for each performance on a temporary basis. Ald. David seconded and the motion was approved.
9. Supt. Owens announced that the State Health Department will not approve the use of the water from Roe Springs.
10. Supt. Owens said that Modern Maid Homes would like to have the city cut a street into their property.
11. W. C. "Billy" Burdette was appointed to the Zoning Board of Appeals, succeeding the late J. D. Anderson, Sr., on motion of Ald. Cox and Holland.
12. Ald. David moved that Mrs. Edna Langford be reappointed to the Recreation Commission for an additional five year term. 2nd by Ald. Cox and unanimously passed.
13. Clerk read letter from the Georgia Municipal Association re the revenue sharing plan of President Nixon.
14. Asst. Supt. Fox advised that the Indian River Construction Co. had men on the site of the proposed sewage treatment plant.
15. Chief Hayes was assured by the Council that his department has the authority to make arrests on US 41N, SR 225 and Industrial Boulevard.
16. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Holland and done.
