

DEC. 27, 1971 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON, ALDERMEN COX, DAVID, HOLLAND AND PADGETT PRESENT.


1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the regular meeting of Dec. 13 and the called meeting of Dec. 17 read and approved.
3. Ald. David moved to accept the following parcels for annexation by petition: Parafar, Inc., Rosewood Rug, Inc., Hand Exterminating Co., Mrs. A. R. McDaniel, Jr., Dr. J. T. Locklear, James H. Burns and Ross Carpenter on N. Wall St. and M/M Charlie D. "Bill" Clark, Carl B. Crump and Jimmy L. McDonald on Cherokee Drive. Mr. David emphasized that this property was accepted with the understanding that services will be made available as soon as practicable. Ald. Padgett seconded the motion and it was voted on and approved.
4. Mr. J. C. Boyd asked and received Council's promise not to enter any contracts with Bill Sanders and Associates until the Coosa Valley APDC has completed its study.
5. Retiring Ald. Jack Holland expressed his appreciation to the Council and the department heads for their cooperation during his tenure of office and offered his services any time he might be of assistance.
6. Ald. Padgett asked for strict enforcement of ordinances covering transporting garbage and waste in uncovered vehicles, littering and damaging and/or destroying public property.
7. Ald. Holland moved to accept the offer of Raymond F. King to donate \$40,000.00 toward the extension of sanitary sewer service to his property with the money to be held in escrow prior to construction, but to be refunded on demand if the sewer main is not extended. 2nd by Ald. Cox, voted on and passed.
8. Supt. Owens advised that the Slagle Moss property at the water treatment plant consisted of some 33.6 acres.
9. Ald. Holland moved to pay the 1972 GMA dues; 2nd by Ald. Padgett and passed.
10. Ald. Padgett stated that the left turn situation on Piedmont St. can be improved if the bank will delineate the lanes to the drive in windows.
11. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Holland and done.
