



JUNE 28, 1971 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. In the absence of Chaplain T. J. Lance, Ronald F. Chance opened the meeting with the reading of a poem from Walt Whitman's "Leaves of Grass".
2. Minutes of the June 14 meeting read and approved.
3. Mayor Dickinson and the Board of Aldermen agreed to consider an application for a malt beverage license from Charlie Butler only if Mr. Butler accepts the following conditions: 1. No firearms will be allowed on the premises; 2. His wife is not allowed in the place of business; 3. He must post bond and pay license fee in advance; 4. License will not be prorated and 5. He must have a reliable male employee acceptable to Chief Hayes.
4. Ald. Padgett heard in regard to Buford Textile dumping latex in an open ditch. Supt. Owens to see that this is corrected.
5. Ald. Padgett suggested placing an ad in the local papers asking residents to number their houses.
6. Supt. Owens advised that the new two million gallon reservoir is half-full and that the raw water pump will be delivered in 6 weeks. Mr. Owens stated that the water pump for Conasauga Heights will be in service by June 29.
7. Supt. Owens announced that the condemnation suits on the Oothca-loga St. project are now being heard by Judge J. L. Davis.
8. Supt. Owens requested a leave of absence from July 17 to Aug. 16. Request granted following motion of Ald. Holland and second of Ald. Cox.
9. Ald. Holland moved to designate Edmond Circle one way with traffic to flow from its north entrance to its south exit; 2nd by Ald. Padgett and approved.
10. Elec. Supt. Bell advised that the power will be off from July 3 to July 11 in the recreational area while transformers are installed.
11. The property of Bessie Lewis on Yarborough St. was annexed by petition following motion of Ald. Holland, 2nd of Ald. David.
12. Ald. Holland moved the passage of a resolution awarding the contract for water treatment facility improvements in the amount of \$996,622.00 to S. J. Curry & Co. of Albany, Ga. 2nd by Ald. David and unanimously approved.
13. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and done.
