City Council met in regular session with all members being present.

Chief R.C. Hayes opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and approved by the Council.

Mayor Hoyt Edwards gave a report to the Council on the recent Georgia Municipal Convention held in Macon and attended by himself Alderman Spink and Alderman Woods. Reported the convention was attended by a large crowd and many views were exchanged and thought a lot was learned from each other.

Mr. David reported that a Fire School was to be held in Rome on August 2, 3, and 4th. Thinks firemen from the Calhoun Department should attend. Mr. Woods stated that arrangements was being made to attend the school.

Mr. David reported that the colored citizens had requested a Colored Policeman for the Westside of the City. No Action taken.

Mr. Woods made a motion that the Civil Defense Department be given \$25.00 to \$30.00 to pay for a picnic held recently on Allatoona Lake. This motion received a second from Mr. Spink voted on and passed.

Mr. Spink stated to the council that he thought the City should consider purchasing a finger printing camera to be used in police work. Lt. Hayes and Patrolmen Reed had finished a finger printing school held in Rome recently and stated the camera would be a big benefit to the department. Mayor Edwards instructed Alderman Dickinson and Chief Hayes to purchase said camera if needed.

Street and property lines at Mr. Guy Abbott's and Mr. R. G. McClure ~~were~~ discussed at this time. There seem to be a question of where the street and property lines met. Mayor Edwards and Mr. Spink stated they would look into the matter.

Mr. Dickinson made a motion that Mr. A.R. McDaniel Jr. be paid two weeks seperation pay. This motion received a second from Mr. David voted on and passed.

Council decided to hold a meeting on Wednesday, July 29th to discuss what would be done about the replacement for Mr. A.R. McDaniel Jr. Said meeting would be held at the City Hall at 1 P.M./

Council decided to meet on Monday, August 3 at 7:30 P.M. to start work on property taxes for the year 1959.

There being no other business Mr. Dickinson made a motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.
