

MARCH 9, 1959
CALHOUN, GEORGIA

City Council met in regular session at the City Hall with all members present.

Chief Hayes opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Clerk and approved by the Council.

Mr. Thurman Roberts was present and requested the Council to furnish him water to the top of Brogdon Mountain since he was going to build some houses at this site. It was explained that this area was too high to give pressure to residents at this site. After discussion the council instructed City Engineer A. R. McDaniel Jr. to get with Mr. Roberts and see what could be worked out between the City and Mr. Roberts.

Mr. Vern Kuhlman and Mr. Kenneth Taylor were present at the meeting. Mr. Kuhlman was interested in getting water run to some property he had purchased behind the Nation's Hill Road. Stated to the council that he planned to build a subdivision at this site and was willing to pay for the cost of the pipe for running water to his land if the City would reimburse him as each house was built and water tap paid for. Mr. Taylor asked that the water line be run at an angle to his property line so that it would not interfere with lots that he planned to sell at a future date. After discussion Mr. David made a motion that a 4" water line be run from the Jones Road to the Kuhlman property at a cost of approximately \$5,000.00 with Mr. Kuhlman paying for the cost of the line and the City would reimburse him at the rate of approximately \$200.00 per tap until said line was paid for. City of Calhoun would pay the water line at no cost to Mr. Kuhlman after said pipe had been paid for. This motion was seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed. It was understood that a right of way easement would be worked out between Mr. Kenneth Taylor and the City of Calhoun.

Mr. Woods stated that Mr. C. B. Clark had low water pressure and requested the City to take action to correct same.

Mr. Spink stated that he thought a fire plug was needed on the road to Buford Textile. Mr. McDaniel stated that a plug for this site was included in the plans. Mr. Spink also asked Mr. McDaniel to get bids for a fence around the city barn.

Mr. Spink reported that the Recreation Commission had a meeting and was investigating the possibility of a full time recreation director. Stated that the term of Mr. Vassa Cate had expired and requested the council to appoint a new member to the Recreation Commission. Also stated that Mr. J.H. Hobgood had been elected chairman of the Recreation Commission.

Mr. Spink nominated Mr. Bert Lance to the Recreation Commission for a period of 5 years. This was seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

Mr. David made a motion that the City of Calhoun appropriate \$640.00 per month starting April 1, 1959 for the Calhoun Recreation Commission and this amount be appropriated until June 1, 1960. This motion was seconded by Mr. Spink voted on and passed.

Mr. David requested the City Engineer to look into the cost of paving a lot 120 x 120 at the Calhoun High School. Thickness was to be 2" thick.

Council instructed the City Engineer to install a backstop at the baseball field, clean and paint the swimming pool and equipment and clean around the baseball and football areas. Requested that the Recreation Commission see that the area is kept clean.

Mayor Edwards reported to the Council that Mr. H. J. Miller had requested that the City of Calhoun pay him an additional \$1,000.00 for the lot that the water storage tank now stands on at the East side of Dale Avenue. Council decided to offer Mr. Miller \$500.00 until 12 midnight March 12th, 1959 after this time the offer will be discontinued. This was put in a form of a motion by Mr. David seconded by Mr. Woods voted on and passed.

David made motion to pay Mr. Joe Aycock the sum of \$15.00 for ~~jury~~ ^{Witness} duty. This motion seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed. *W. A. Roach Clerk*

Mr. Dickinson made motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.
