

June 8, 1959
Calhoun, Georgia

City Council met in regular session with all members present.

Chief Hayes opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and approved by the council.

Mr. Roger K. Brown the new City of Calhoun Recreation Director was present at the meeting and was introduced to the council by Mr. James H. Hobgood chairman of the recreation commission. Mr. Brown stated that he was glad to be in Calhoun and would try and do his best to have a good recreation program for the City. Stated that his office would be in the Civic Center Building.

Mr. Vassa Cate Superintendent of City Schools was present at the meeting and ask the council what was their feeling toward him having an office in the Civic Center Building. Stated that the offices at the high school were crowded and more space was necessary. Board of Education requested that the council give consideration to office space for the superintendent in the Civic Building. After discussion Mr. Dickinson made a motion that space in the south portion of the main floor be given for school offices with the Board of Education bearing the expense of enclosure from the brick columns to the ^{300 ft}walls. This motion was seconded by Mr. Woods voted on and passed.


Mr. David wanted to know what could be done to furnish sewerage to Mr. R.H. Bishop and others on the South portion of Victory Drive. Instructed City Engineer to look into matter. Also stated he had complaints of low water pressure from Howard Gravitt's Service Station to Wisteria Drive-In along South Wall Street. Instructed City Engineer to look into the matter and see what could be done to correct same.

Mr. Bill Spink made a motion that the City use up to \$8,500.00 out of the Cemetery Fund to purchase a ditch digger as of July 1, 1959. That payments be made back to the cemetery fund on a monthly basis until said money had been replaced but this must not be later that December 31, 1959. This motion received a second from Mr. Woods voted on and passed. Mayor Edwards appointed Mr. Spink and Mr. Dickinson to a committee to look after said purchase.

Mayor Edwards reported that Mrs. Lois Chastain had complained to him that the cemetery mower was throwing rocks against her house and had broken ^{Two} ~~one~~ of the windows. ^{SCREENS} Council agreed to have grass mowed at a higher level next to the house to take care of this situation ^{AND TO REPLACE SCREENS.}

City Engineer A. R. McDaniel Jr. Suggested to the council th t they pass an ordinance requiring all contractors to use 100 amp cutin boxes and 3/4 inch water taps. City Engineer to get with city attorney and draw up ordinance.

Council voted to give all city employees a one week vacation that had been working for a period of six months or more. Motion made by Mr. Dickinson seconded by Mr. Woods voted on and passed.
