City Council met in regular session at the City Hall with all members being present except Mr. Woods who was away at National Guard Camp.

Chief Hayes opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Clerk and approved by the Council.

A delegation from the Sonoraville Road was present at the meeting and presented a petition to the Mayor and Council with 52 names requesting that water be run to the Mae Whitner property on the Sonoraville Road. The delegation stated that the distance involved was approximately 4 miles. After discussion the Mayor instructed Mr. Caldwell and Mr. Lewis to look into the matter and report their finding at the next Council meeting.

A letter from the City School Board requesting \$50,000.00 from the City for operations of the City School System for the year 1959-60 was read by the Mayor at this time. Council agreed to give the request consideration.

Mr. Spink reported that the sidewalk in front of the Thomas Funeral Home was in need of repair. No action taken.

Mr. David reported that a request had been made that two parking spaces in front of the Civic Center be marked off for school officials. Council decided against this action.

A water petition from the New Town section was read at this time. The distance involved was approximately 1 mile with 12 signers. Council tabled the matter as money was a question at this time.

A water petition from the Hall Memorial Road was read by the Mayor. the distance involved was approximately 1.0 miles and 9 signers had signed the petition. Council decided it would take more signers before the line could be run.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
