After discussion it was decided that the present plan of the Gulf Life Insurance Company would be no good if another plan was in effect, therefore, the payroll insurance idea was dropped.

The meeting was interrupted by a fire call at the Scott Sanitarium in the Reeves Community. All Aldermen and the mayor helped carry equipment to the fire.
