

DECEMBER 14, 1959
Calhoun, Georgia

City Council met in regular session at the City Hall with members being present except Mr. David who was out of the city on a hunting trip.

Police Chief Crofford Hayes opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and approved by the council.

Alderman elect W. R. Norton was a visitor at the meeting and was welcomed by Mayor Edwards.

Christmas bonus for all city employees was discussed at this time. After discussion Alderman Woods made a motion that all department heads of the city be given 25% of their monthly salaries, all monthly salaried employees be given \$50.00, and all hourly employees be given \$30.00 for Christmas bonus. This motion received a second from Mr. Dickinson and was voted on and passed.

Alderman Woods reported that a storm sewer drain needed fixing at the corner of King and Oothcalooga Streets and a hole in the street at the corner of River and Oothcalooga Streets needed repairing.


Mayor Edwards reported that the Dave Nelson family had moved into the S. J. Dobson property on South Piedmont Street. The Dobson property was purchased by the city and given to the Dave R. Nelson family in exchange for the Dave R. Nelson property on West Line Street. The building of the new street by the Dave R. Nelson property causing damage to the Line Street property was the reason for the exchange. Council decided to look into the possibility of borrowing money on the property to help relieve the expense until the Nelson property could be sold. When Line Street property is sold money from sale will be used to help pay for the Dobson Property.

Mayor Edwards reported that "M" day was to be held at the Georgia State Mental Hospital on Wednesday, December 16, 1959. The "M" day or "Mayors Day" was to be sponsored by the Georgia Municipal Association and all mayors were to carry gifts from their cities. Alderman Spink made a motion that the sum of \$100.00 be authorized for use by Mayor Edwards in purchasing gifts and expenses. This motion received a second from Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

A motion was made by Alderman Woods that the Georgia Power Company be given a job work order for furnishing materials necessary to install the regulators and circuit breaker at the sub-station and bill the City of Calhoun when the work was finished. This motion received a second from Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
