

November 23, 1959
Calhoun, Georgia

City Council met in regular session at the city hall with all members present.

Chief Hayes opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the meetings of November 4, and November 9th were read and approved by the council.

Alderman Woods brought up matter of Mr. Burl Stephens, operator of Troy's Grill wanting the city to discontinue allowing beer retailers to serve beer on curb. After discussion, it was decided to let Mayor Edwards contact Mr. Stephens to see if a satisfactory solution could be worked out.

Alderman Spink reports that property owners on Court Street want city to install storm sewers and then they will put up money for curb and gutter. After discussion, it was decided that if property owners on South side of Court Street would put up their money the city would install the storm sewers.

Alderman Dickinson reported that the City Clerk wanted the New License Ordinance Books printed as soon as possible. After discussion it was decided that each member of the council review the License Book as now printed and see if any changes are to be made. The date for any changes would be by November 28, 1959.

Alderman David made a motion that a committee be appointed to investigate the financing of a new fire truck. This motion received a second from Mr. Spink voted on and passed. Mayor Edwards appointed Alderman Woods and Alderman David to the committee.



Mayor Edwards stated to the Council that the Calhoun High School Seniors wanted the City to buy an ad in the school annual. It was decided that it was not possible for the city to expend money for this purpose.

Alderman Dickinson made a motion that the City buy a standby unit for traffic lights. This motion received a second from Mr. Spink voted on and passed.

There being no other business Mr. David made a motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted and passed.
