

JULY 13, 1967 - CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR

1. Paul Shoffner, chairman of the City Board of Education, Robert D. Cox, principal of Calhoun High School and Ellis K. Hite, vocational instructor were present to explain the school's need for the A. M. Owen property adjacent to the high school. In answer to Mayor Dickinson's query, Mr. Cox said the building could be used for office space, storage, instructional and/or recreational purposes. It was explained that it would be used temporarily for the vocational technical school pending completion of their new building. Ald. David made the motion to purchase the property for the quoted price of \$12,500.00. Ald. King seconded and they and Ald. Woods voted for the motion.
