
CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR FRANK M. DICKINSON,
ALDERMEN TOM B. DAVID, ARDEN J. KING AND J. T. WOODS, JR. PRES*
ENT. ALDERMAN JOHN A. LEWIS, JR. ABSENT.

1. The property at the intersection of River and W. Line Sts. was leased to the Kayo Oil Co. of Chattanooga, Tenn. for a term of five years with privilege of renewal. Kayo is to pay \$60.00 monthly and pay half the cost of a retaining wall on the south side of the property. Ald. King made the motion, seconded by Ald. David, to enter into this lease which was voted and passed.
2. Supt. Owens acquired bids on a roller for the Street Dept. with Bradley Equipment offering a Ferguson for \$5,650.00, Road Machinery a Rex at \$5365.00 and Tri-State Tractor a Galion at \$5,850.00. Ald. King made motion to buy the Galion from Tri-State, seconded by Ald. Woods, Voted and passed.
3. Acting upon the request of James H. Payne to salvage metal and wire from the garbage dump, the Council refused to allow Mr. Payne or anyone else to enter the dump except for the purpose of dumping garbage.
4. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
