1. Mayor Meadows welcomed everyone to the meeting, and introduced employees of the City of Calhoun who would be available to make presentations and to answer questions.
2. Kelly Cornwell, Director of Utilities/Public Works, reviewed the sewer estimate and the water improvement cost estimate, and reviewed the location for the proposed line extension.
3. City Administrator Cathy Harrison reviewed the annexation process. She also reviewed taxes, water and insurance rates associated with annexation which would be beneficial for residents in the area.
4. Mayor Meadows reviewed the presentations made by both Cornwell and Harrison, and opened the floor for questions from the public. Those questions raised were as follows: Would it be necessary for all to be annexed? The response was yes. It would require full annexation and full participation from the group in order to spread the cost more effectively and make the project feasible. The group stated that all the homes were represented at the meeting with the exception of two, and the group asked that the City Administrator forward ballots to the group to vote on whether or not they would be interested in annexation and sewer extension, and following return of those ballots to notify the group of the results.
5. There were no further comments, and the meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:00 P.M.
