


1. Mayor Meadows opened the meeting.
2. Mayor Meadows explained the tax assessment figures had been released, and the City was now required to set the millage based upon the needs of the City and the City school as defined in the 1986 - 87 budgets.
3. Following discussion, Ald. King made a motion to set the millage at a net of 16.5 mills, the same as 1985 prior to the State factor, 2nd by Ald. Oldfield with Ald. McEntire and Ald. Bond voting affirmatively, motion carried.
4. Supt. Hobgood stated he needed direction from the Council on a matter which they could officially approve or disapprove on August 25, 1986. He stated the Tierce development on Highway 156 was requiring the clearing of 21 acres. He stated the developer had requested permission to burn the debris at night to eliminate further hauling. He stated the situation was a little different than clearing a 1 acre lot, in the midst of several homes. He stated the brush and trees had been piled in areas completely surrounded by barren soil and the burning could be controlled. He stated the fire dept. could be called and in attendance the night of the burning in case a spark drifted. Following discussion, Mayor Meadows asked for a poll from each Council member as to what he would approve officially on August 25, 1986.
  - Ald. Bond - would permit at the discretion of Supt. Hobgood, provided the developer understand the liability is his for any damages caused by the fire.
  - Ald. King - would permit at Supt. Hobgood's discretion;
  - Ald. Oldfield and Ald. McEntire stated the same.
5. Ald. Oldfield made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem King with Ald. McEntire and Ald. Bond voting affirmatively, motion carried.
