

Special Meeting  
June 4th, 1958

Mayor Edwards called a special meeting of the Council to take care of some matters since Mr. Spink and Mr. Woodson would be out of town at the next regular meeting time.

The project of running water out Highway 225 to the crossroad at the Elk's Club was discussed at this time. Mr. McDaniel reported that the cost of the pipe would be approximately \$ 15,000.00. A petition requesting the city to run this water had been turned in in the summer of '57. There would be left in the Water and Sewerage Construction Fund approximately \$15,000.00 after the Plainville and Sugar Valley project were finished and with no labor cost on the Plainville being paid to the city. There was also a possibility that the Echota Cotton Mill would want to tie in the mill house on the city water system. After much discussion Mr. Dickinson made a motion that the running of the water line out Highway #225 to the crossroad at the Elk's Club be postpone. This motion was seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.

City Council agreed to charge Mrs. Mattie Hicks for one water tap and for one minimum each month.

The paving of Oak Street brought up for discussion. Mr. Spink made a motion that Oak Street be paved when 2/3 of property owners paid in advance for the paving charges. This motion seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

The city sewerage problem discussed. The council instructed the city engineer to make a survey of the problem and think in terms of getting more money through the sale of more water and sewer revenue certificates to take care of any additional water expansion and the sewer expansion needed.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
