City Council met in special session, for purpose of receiving Bids on \$30,000.00 Bond issue for General Purpose Improvement Bonds, all members present.

Mayor Lawrence opened bids, and read as follows:--

Tindall & Company bid \$30,412.20

Johnson, Lane, Space & Co. bid \$30,825.00

The Robinson Humphrey Co. bid \$30,113.10

Calhoun National Bank bid \$30,000.00

Mr. David made motion to accept bid of Johnson, Lane Space and Co. of \$30,825.00, seconded by Mr. Edwards, Voted on and passes.

At this time, the visitors departed, and the following additional business was conducted -

Mr. David made motion to install pipe on S. Victory Drive large enough to give all residences adequate water, seconded by Mr. Edwards, voted on and passed.

Mr. Woods made motion that property owners pay for pipe used, and the City furnish all labor to install storm drain between Woodlawn and College Streets, seconded by Mr. David, voted on and passed.

No other business, Mr. David made motion to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Caldwell, voted on and passed.
