

SEPTEMBER 15, 1979 - SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE, ALD. LEWIS,
ALD. COX, ALD. KING AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE

1. Call to order and invocation by Mayor Burdette.
2. Ald. Pack made a motion to approve the request of Roy Dodd to hold a disco dance at the National Guard Armory on Oct. 5, 1979, for Muscular Dystrophy. The time to be 7:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. for children under 13 and 9:30 p.m. until 1:00 a.m. for those over 13. No alcoholic beverages to be allowed with security enforcement by the City Police Dept. and Civil Defense volunteers. 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. King and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.
3. Ald. Pack made a motion to deny the license request for Tim Smith for a pin ball machine for the record shop next to City Hall, on North Wall Street. 2nd by Ald. Cox, with Ald. Lewis and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
4. Ald. Lewis made a motion to grant a 90 day extension to Mrs. Genevieve Van Buskirk on the condemnation of three houses on South Wall Street, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.
5. After discussion on the trailer request from Coosa Valley Tech and Challenge Cook, Ald. King made a motion to grant a 6 months permit to allow the trailer to be used for classroom training; 2nd by Ald. Lewis and approved.
6. A general discussion followed on the School Board's request to amend the budget by \$25,000.00. Ald. Lewis made a motion to approve the request, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Cox and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively also.
7. Ald. Cox made a motion to set the 1979 ad valorem tax millage at 13 mills, a reduction of 3 mills. 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Lewis and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
8. Ald. Pack made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Lewis with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
