

Special Meeting
July 12, 1957


Mayor Lawrence called a special meeting of the council to discuss action on the City of Calhoun extending its water line to the Town of Plainville.

Alderman Tom David And Alderman J.T.Woods Jr. Were absent from the meeting.

The Plainville delegation reported that they had more than 10 people signed for water since the last meeting. On the information to date there would be approximately 190 customers plus two schools which would return in revenue approximately \$753.00 per month. The amount needed to borrow the \$130,000.00 was \$865.00 per month. The City would have to subsidize the project approximately \$100.00 per month. After much discussion Mr. Edwards made a motion that subject to the approval of the bonding company on \$130,000.00 at 5% the water line be run to the Town of Plainville at the earliest possible date. This motion seconded by Mr. Frank Dickinson , motion carried.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
