

APRIL 18, 1972 - CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON,
ALDERMEN COX AND PADGETT PRESENT.

This meeting called at the request of Wayne L. Ashworth, Supt. of Gordon County Schools. Mr. Ashworth and Red Bud Principal Harden A. Oldfield explained their need for city water at the school and agreed to pay regular water bills monthly plus interest on the estimated \$45,000.00 cost to extend the six inch some three miles, less any customers who agree to pay monthly minimums and the \$125.00 tap fee. Ald. Padgett moved to accept this offer and extend the water main to serve the Red Bud Schools. Ald. Cox seconded the motion and it was approved with the concurrence of Mayor Dickinson.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
