Dear Dee:

Thank you for meeting with the Calhoun contingent on May 21, 2014 to discuss a bicycle race scheduled for June 21, 2014. The criterium is a multi-race event and requires a quarter mile section, in down town, of SR3, be closed to vehicular traffic for four to four and a half hours. Below are the items we discussed during our meeting with you.

The closing of SR3 would be from 3:30 P.M. until 7:30 P.M. and would involve north and south bound lanes. Re-routing of southbound SR3 traffic would be detoured east and west Line Street. North bound SR3 truck traffic would route west on Oak Street to River Street. North bound SR3 car traffic would detour on Piedmont Street which is a north/south parallel to SR3. Incoming, east bound SR53 spur traffic would be detoured to River Street. The City of Calhoun will be responsible for all required traffic control measures, devices, and enforcement. Calhoun will have five to six policemen at the appropriate intersections along with signage indicating routing. We will have Calhoun Public Works personnel, who have training in traffic control, provide assistance to the Police Department.

As always Calhoun will be responsible for this event and any problems which might occur. No ingress or egress for home owners or commercial activities will be effected. All business owners who are not closed on Saturday afternoon will be contacted and informed of the race, route, detours, and time schedule. We are aware if there is some type of rerouting of I-75 due to a accident or other event, the race will be immediately stopped.

Thanks again for your assistance in providing Calhoun with a feasible way to boost down town activity and economic development in a safe and practical manner for all concerned.
