

JULY 24, 1963 - CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR FRANK DICKINSON, ALDERMEN TOM B. DAVID, JOHN A LEWIS, JR. AND J. T. WOODS, JR. PRESENT. ALD. JERRY KING ON VACATION.

1. The purpose of the meeting was the opening of bids and the letting of a contract on Water System Improvements Project APW-Ga-49G. Mr. Bill Greene, of Wiedeman & Singleton, the City's consulting engineers, read the bids which were as follows:

Ald. Woods made motion to award contract to Brown Bros. of Chattanooga in the amount of \$120,431.10 with the City to pay all costs of the completed contract over and above the amount allowable under the HHFA grant. Ald. David seconded the motion which was voted on and passed unanimously. Brown Bros. to complete project in 150 consecutive calendar days from date of issuance of work order from Wiedeman & Singleton.
