

April 22, 1982 - 5:15 P.M. SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,  
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. COX, ALD. KING AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order.
2. City Supt. Hobgood stated that the Talley property on River Street had been purchased. (\$10,000.00) Other property in the area was discussed which will be needed to do the widening as planned.  
City Supt. Hobgood also discussed the additional property needed at the Waste Treatment Plant, 13.63 acres.
3. John Sweitzer of Sweitzer & Peoples Engineers, discussed the proposed agreement for the City of Calhoun and City of Fairmount regarding whole-sale water, minimum charges and etc.  
Ald. Cox made a motion authorizing the Mayor and City Supt. Hobgood to negotiate the agreement with the Fairmount Council and to authorize the Mayor to sign the agreement as proposed to the Calhoun Council, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Lewis voting affirmative also.
4. A first reading was given to the annexation request of the Calhoun First National Bank for 3.36 acres off Highway 53 for C-2 zoning.
5. Ald. Lewis made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Pack and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
