

Call to order by Mayor Burdette.

A motion was made by Ald. Collins to sign a resolution authorizing Hoyt Edwards as the City's representative and authorizing Mayor Burdette to execute the Municipal Electric Authority of Ga. Contract at such time as is appropriate, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.

Attorney Tom Shanahan stated that the Council needed to state their willingness to accept or deny any liability for the incident involving the tractor-trailer truck and the city power line across I-75 in front of Scottish Inns. According to the City Electric Superintendent, Jack Bell, as far as he and his department could determine the incident was a result of lightning during a thunderstorm on Saturday, May 3, 1975. The Council upon advice of Attorney Tom Shanahan and Jack Bell will deny any liability for the accident.

Mayor Burdette stated that he would like approval to order paint to begin preparations for relocating the Day Care Center. Ald. Cox made the motion to approve the purchase but to ask County Commissioner for some assistance on the project, 2nd by Ald. Collins and approved.

A motion was made by Ald. Cox to authorize the Mayor to borrow some \$150,000.00 should the need arise during the month of June, 1975, 2nd by Ald. Collins and approved.

A motion was made by Ald. Collins to approve some additional grading and paving at the back of the Recreation Community Center, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.
