

CITY COUNCIL MET IN CALLED SESSION FRIDAY, SEPT. 14, 1962

1. Ald. King requested and council instructed city attorney to secure easement from Judge J. H. Paschall so that city may widen and surface Sequoyah Terrace. Mr. Paschall reported willing to grant easement provided street remain one way during his lifetime.
2. Request of Burkhardt Amusement Co. to operate show, consisting of rides only, on lot of T & T Supermarket was ^{unanimously} denied on motion of Ald. Lewis and second of Ald. King.
3. On motion of Ald. King, second of Ald. David, Hoyt Edwards was appointed city clerk effective Sept. 15, 1962 at same salary as predecessor.
