



1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Bids were reviewed on the North Calhoun Industrial Park water and sewer extension projects. Mayor Burdette stated according to the Engineer's report, they had reviewed the bids and recommended the City award Contract one (water) to Stancil Brothers Trenching, Inc. of Jasper, Ga. for \$161,015.80 and Contract two (sewer) to Marvin Shuler Construction Company of Calhoun for \$40,512.70. The project total being about 5% under the project budget. Following discussion, Ald. Meadows made a motion to award contract one to Stancil Brothers Trenching, Inc. for \$161,015.80 and contract two to Marvin Shuler Construction Company for \$40,512.70, 2nd by Ald. King with Mayor Pro-Tem Lewis voting affirmatively, motion carried.
3. Bids were opened on the electric shop building on Park Avenue as had been advertised. The bids were:
 - Echota Fabrics - \$65,000.00
 - Philip Beamer - \$66,100.00
 - Woodland Chippers \$97,500.00The Council stated a decision of an award or refusal would be made at the January 14, 1985 Council meeting. The reason for waiting was due to a failure to purchase a new site on River Street, and would allow the Council time to review other sites being considered.
4. Ald. King made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Meadows with Mayor Pro-Tem Lewis voting affirmatively, motion carried.
