

SEPT. 18, 1973 - SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT

1. Merrill Dobbs proposed a solution for the Victory Drive problem. City will get a county contract with the State Highway Department to do engineering work to determine cost. The Shopping Center Corp. will pay for the right of way necessary to complete the project so Peters Street and Victory Drive would then come out at the same place. Highway engineer recommends curbs and gutters on Victory Drive. Motion by Ald. Mathews 2nd by Ald. Cox to proceed with county state contract. Carried.

3. Ald. Cox brought up old school building. Referred to Hoyt Edwards to get update on bids to tear it down.
