

1. Call to order by Mayor Burdette.
2. A motion was made by Ald. Collins to declare a moratorium on issuing any beer, wine or liquor licenses until Jan. 1, 1976, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and approved.
3. Ald. Collins made a motion to accept the bid of Arch Roberts & Co. as the agent in the pending G.O. Bond referendum, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and approved.
4. Bids were opened for a new roof on the Day Care Center educational building: R. F. Taylor Roofing & Sheet Metal Co. - \$2,720.00 to install 15 year smooth surface; Rome Sheet Metal - \$3,705.00 for 20 year without insulation, \$5,194.00 with insulation. Motion by Ald. Cox to accept R. F. Taylor bid, 2nd by Ald. Collins and approved.
5. The Council asked that the regulations now on record regarding signs at business establishments be followed.
6. The Council agreed to curb 500 additional feet on the north side of Chandler Street from Pisgah Way to Woodlawn.
7. The manhole located on Mr. F. D. Duffey's property on Highway 53 was discussed. Asst. Manager Roy Fox recommended lowering the manhole and covering with fill dirt.
8. Meeting was adjourned.
