

1. Mayor Meadows opened the meeting, stating the purpose of the meeting was to hold a public hearing regarding the proposed tax millage for 1994. Mayor Meadows opened the public hearing, and reviewed the notices published in the Calhoun Times regarding the City M&O taxes and the proposed rollback, as well as the proposed M&O taxes for the city school system, and discussed the loan and bond funds for the city school system. Following discussion regarding budgeting philosophies of the City and the city school system, there were no additional comments, and the public hearing was closed. Mayor Pro-Tem Bond made a motion to set the total city tax millage for the school, school bonds/debt and City M&O less rollback at 17.34 mills for 1994, as was recommended by the City Administrator, 2nd by Councilman McEntire with Mayor Pro-Tem Bond, Councilman McEntire, Councilman Shelton and Councilman Palmer voting affirmatively, motion carried.
2. Councilman McEntire made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem Bond with Councilman McEntire, Mayor Pro-Tem Bond, Councilman Shelton and Councilman Palmer voting affirmatively, motion carried.
