

MARCH 5, 1963 - SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR FRANK M. DICKINSON , ALDERMEN TOM B. DAVID, ARDEN J. KING, JOHN A. LEWIS, JR. AND J. T. WOODS, JR. PRESENT.

1. Mr. Harry Lawrence advised council that Mr. T. F. Chitwood was interested in building a carpet mill and laundry at Resaca in the immediate future, if the city would furnish adequate water for a sprinkler system. Mr. Lawrence said there was a possibility of a yarn mill locating nearby at a later date and also told council that Mr. Chitwood would guarantee a \$500.00 monthly minimum for water. Motion by Ald. Lewis, 2nd by Ald. David, to furnish this location with ample water supply. Unan. vote for.
2. Mr. Lawrence told council that the owners of Gordon Hills Shopping Center would permit no beer licenses there.
3. Mr. Lawrence showed council plat of proposed subdivision to be known as Garden Hills & Spring Acres and asked council for letter of intent to serve with all city utilities. Clerk instructed to write letter to Mr. Lawrence assuring him of council's desire to bring this area into city and supply water, power and sewerage.
4. Ald. David made report on meetings held regarding a junior college for Gordon County.
5. At request of clerk, council re-affirmed their position on late payment of water & light bills which is that penalty will be collected on all such late payments.
6. Ald. King made motion that city adopt all-electric rate of one cent (1¢) per kilowatt for residential (domestic) users. Voted on and unanimously passed.
7. Ald. Lewis said he had talked with local ~~men~~ funeral directors and that they would like to continue opening and closing graves, but were perfectly willing to have city sexton show their men where graves are to be dug and give him complete control of this.
8. Council, on motion of Ald. Lewis, passed a resolution authorizing the execution of a cooperation agreement between the city and the housing authority.
9. No further business, meeting adjourned.
