

JANUARY 28, 1988 - 7:00 P.M. CITY COURTROOM PIEDMONT STREET, CALHOUN, GEORGIA, CDBG HEARING WITH MAYOR MEADOWS, MAYOR PRO-TEM KING, COUNCILMAN BOND, COUNCILMAN OLDFIELD, COUNTY COMMISSIONER JOYCE HOPPER, COUNTY COMMISSIONER MAX SCOTT, CITY SUPERINTENDENT JIM HOBGOOD AND CITY CLERK HARRISON IN ATTENDANCE.

1. Mayor Meadows called the meeting to order, opened the hearing and expressed the purpose of the meeting.
2. Mayor Meadows explained the grant process, and asked those in attendance if they had any specific projects in mind.
3. The response being sewer lines in Fox Subdivision.
4. Mayor Meadows and Engineer Sweitzer stated the City/County desired to file a joint application for sewerage in Fox Subdivision for \$400,000.00. The area would be in Phase III and would affect approximately 113 homes. The project would be for approximately 10,000 ft. of sewer main and approximately 14,000 ft. of lateral lines. Connections would be made to the homes, one per house and the only cost for the occupant would be the monthly bill which would be based on water consumption.
5. The City would replace water lines as needed and install fire hydrants provided by the County and the County would pave the streets with aid of DOT contracts.
6. Lloyd Frazier of Coosa Valley Area Planning and Development Commission explained the grant application process and the odds of being funded. He stated the City and County should receive notice in 45 to 60 days.
7. Mayor Meadows discussed the present sewer tap fees for County residents to indicate the savings. He also stated Cecil Byars with the Health Department had endorsed the application as being needed for the area.
8. There were no further comments or questions and the hearing was closed.
