

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order.
2. The Council reviewed a letter, plot and affidavit from Howard Jones, Attorney-at-law, representing Allen Chapel. The Church requested a return of a lot fronting on River Street being 60 ft. x 100 ft. lying behind Allen Chapel which according to the affidavit was supposed to have been returned to Allen Chapel in 1929 in exchange for 3 acres.
After further discussion Ald. Cox made a motion authorizing the Mayor to sign a deed granting Allen Chapel title to the lot after legal verification by the City Attorney. Seconded by Ald. Harwell and approved.
3. The Mayor and Aldermen discussed a request by WEBBS Radio to block Court Street on Friday night July 1, 1977 for a street dance sponsored by WEBBS and several merchants. The general conscience of the Council was that blocking of a public street could only be done for a non-profit organization and then on a limited basis. No official decision was made.
4. The City Superintendent, Jim Hobgood, and City Clerk--Treasurer, presented their 1977-78 preliminary budget to the Council. A general discussion followed.
5. Ald. Harwell made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Cox and approved.
