

November 1, 1955

City Council met in call session on Tuesday at 2:P. M. for the purpose of receiving and opening bids for new reservoir of 1,000,000 capacity. The following members present, Mayor Lawrence, Calvin Caldwell, and Hoyt Edwards. Mr. Bill Green of Wiedeman Singleton was also present.

Mayor Lawrence read the bids as follows:

1. Chicago Bridge and Iron Co.---~~40~~^{To B},700. Mr. Campbell, to be completed within 220 Calendar days.
2. Chattanooga Boiler and Tank Co.--~~40~~^{To A},425. Mr. Williams to be completed within 300 Calendar days.
3. Cole Manufacturing Co. of Newman Georgia---~~40~~^{To A},775, Mr. Mayo ^{To A} to be completed within 300 Calendar days.
4. Hammond Iron Works--~~43~~^{To B},950. To be completed within 220 working days.

Chattanooga Boiler and Tank Co. low bidder as to amount of money, but Chicago Bridge and Iron Co. bid \$275 higher but 80 days less completion time which is very important element in deciding.

After deliberation by Mayor and Council and giving other bidders chance to compete in time bidding, Mr. Mayo of Cole mfg. Co. could not change completion date. Mr. Williams of Chattanooga Boiler and Tank promised 250 calendar days which did not meet the 220 days promised by Chicago Bridge and Boiler Co. ^{Iron}

Mr. Edwards made motion to award contract to Chicago Bridge and Iron Co. Seconded by Mr. Caldwell, voted on and unanimously passed.

No other business, meeting adjourned.
