

1. Mayor Meadows called the meeting to order.
2. Following review of proper parliamentary procedure by Attorney Campbell, Mayor Pro-Tem Bond restated his earlier motion to approve the Chamber's budget regarding tourism for the additional 2% hotel-motel tax, 2nd by Councilman Shelton with Mayor Pro-Tem Bond, Councilman Shelton, Councilman Oldfield and Councilman McEntire voting affirmatively, motion carried.
3. Councilman McEntire made a motion to adopt a resolution incorporating the additional hotel-motel tax monies into the City's general budget, 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem Bond with Councilman McEntire, Mayor Pro-Tem Bond, Councilman Shelton and Councilman Oldfield voting affirmatively, motion carried.
4. Councilman McEntire made a motion to authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign an agreement contracting tourism services associated with the hotel-motel tax increase with the Gordon County Chamber of Commerce with the effective date of taxing to begin November 1, 1992, 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem Bond with Councilman McEntire, Mayor Pro-Tem Bond, Councilman Shelton and Councilman Oldfield voting affirmatively, motion carried.
5. Following review, of amended construction cost for the completion of the Sewer Interceptor Project, Councilman Shelton made a motion to adopt a resolution authorizing the preapplication for 1993 SRF funds to complete the sewer interceptor project at an amended amount of \$1,100,000.00, 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem Bond with Councilman Shelton, Mayor Pro-Tem Bond, Councilman Oldfield and Councilman McEntire voting affirmatively, motion carried.
6. The meeting was adjourned.
