

MAY 7, 1984 - 6:00 P.M. SPECIAL CALLED CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH
MAYOR BURDETTE, MAYOR PRO-TEM LEWIS, ALD. KING, ALD.
BENNETT AND ALD. MEADOWS IN ATTENDANCE.

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order.
2. The May 3, 1984 water/sewer installation bidding was discussed. The bid opening was held at 10:00 A.M. in the City Courtroom with only one contractor, Marvin Shuler Construction Company, submitting a bid. The bid, with the approval of the contractor, had been held unopened for the Council to determine their course of action. After discussion, Ald. Meadows made a motion to open the bid and consider, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Bennett and Mayor Pro-Tem Lewis voting affirmatively. The bid bond was by the Eastern Indemnity Company for \$14,992.00 and the total bid was for \$261,390.00. Supt. Hobgood was asked to compare the bid to current cost per phase of work since the bid represents work which may or may not be done at the discretion of the Council. The Supt. was asked to report his conclusions at the May 14, 1984 regular Council meeting.
3. After discussion of the forthcoming DOT contract for resurfacing of .663 miles of Curtis Parkway, Ald. Bennett made a motion to enter into a maintenance agreement with DOT on the area, 2nd by Ald. Meadows with Ald. King and Mayor Pro-Tem Lewis voting affirmatively, motion carried.
4. Ald. Meadows made a motion to adopt a resolution authorizing acquisition and clearance of right-of ways, including any relocation of utilities. 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Bennett and Mayor Pro-Tem Lewis voting affirmatively, motion carried.
5. Discussion was held on the Gene Holbrook request to relocate the Parts City sign to the south side of Highway 53, East with a variance request of 28 ft. Ald. King made a motion to grant the variance subject to annexation of the property, since it would be in substantial alignment with other signs in the area, 2nd by Ald. Bennett with Ald. Meadows and Mayor Pro-Tem Lewis voting affirmatively, motion approved.
6. Ald. Meadows made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Bennett and Mayor Pro-Tem Lewis voting affirmatively.
