



1. Mayor Palmer called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone in attendance.
2. Administrator Peterson gave an overview of the 2009 millage rate proposal for the City and School Board. Peterson reviewed the digest, five year history, the roll back rate, and the formulas and calculations required to set the millage rate.
3. Mayor Palmer asked if there were any questions. There being none Mayor Palmer asked Chairperson Atkinson if the Calhoun City Board of Education had a millage rate recommendation.
 - Chairperson Atkinson recommended the 2009 millage rate for the City School System be set at 13.865 mils.
 - ❖ Councilman Hammond made a motion to set the Calhoun City board of Education millage rate at 13.865 for the 2009 property tax bills. Councilman Denmon second the motion with all voting affirmatively, motion carried.
 - ❖ Councilman Hammond also made a motion to set the City of Calhoun millage rate at 1.591 for the 2009 property tax bills. Councilman Denmon second the motion with all voting affirmatively, motion carried.
4. Mayor Palmer stated with that being said that the 2009 millage rate for the City of Calhoun and City Board of Education was set at 15.456.
5. Councilman Crowley made a motion a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Edwards second the motion with all voting affirmatively, motion carried.
