City School Supt. G. V. Cate presented the 1967-68 school budget requesting \$197,000 from the city.

Mr. Cate said the \$142,000 the city furnished last year lacked some \$33,000 meeting the budget requirements due to unforeseen changes such as teacher salary increases.
