1. City Attorney Elect William P. Bailey and Administrator Harrison reviewed the court appeal made by the City of Fairmount regarding levying taxes for 1992 based on the 1991 digest, and Gordon County's intervention requesting the ability to tax for the Gordon County school system and Gordon County based on a 1992 digest. Harrison stated that Mr. Harold Bennett, Tax Commissioner for Gordon County, had requested the City Council to give him a 1992 millage rate which could be used on the prebills for the vehicle tags at the beginning of 1993. Following further discussion, Councilman Oldfield made a motion to use the millage rate of 17.25 in response to Mr. Harold Bennett's request based on the assessed value of vehicles, real and personal property, and public utility valuations as presented by Wayne Walters, his staff and Harold Bennett, 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem Bond with Councilman Oldfield, Mayor Pro-Tem Bond, Councilman Shelton and Councilman McEntire voting affirmatively, motion carried.
2. Councilman Oldfield made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem Bond with Councilman Oldfield, Mayor Pro-Tem Bond, Councilman Shelton and Councilman McEntire voting affirmatively, motion carried.
