

MAY 19, 1972 - CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

The meeting was called to discuss the proposed mobile homes park on Peters St. and to give the developers approval or refusal to proceed.

Following discussion, Ald. David moved to approve the proposed park provided:

1. All streets are annexed to the city.
2. Each mobile home makes a \$50.00 deposit for utilities.
3. An adequate number of 3 cubic yard garbage containers are maintained with the city supt. to determine the required number.
4. Utilities will not be connected without a current tax stamp.
5. All rules as prescribed by the owners of Creek View Park are accepted and herewith made a part of this agreement.

Ald. Collins seconded the motion and it was passed with Ald. Cox casting the only dissenting vote.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned on motion of Ald. Padgett and Cox.
