1. Mayor Meadows called the meeting to order.
2. Following discussion, Ald. Oldfield made a motion to continue the school tax exemption allowed to City of Calhoun residents who meet the qualifications, and to authorize the Mayor to request State Representative Langford and State Senator Brannon to pass a re-adoption of these sections through the 1987 legislature. The motion was 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem King with Ald. McEntire voting affirmatively, motion carried.
3. Following discussion, Mayor Pro-Tem King made a motion to allow the City of Calhoun to continue funding up to \$5,000.00 annually for VAC, and to authorize the Mayor to request State Representative Langford and State Senator Branon to pass a readoption of these sections through the 1987 legislature. The motion was 2nd by Ald. McEntire with Ald. Oldfield voting affirmatively, motion carried.
