

CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL ON OCTOBER 29 WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT EXCEPT ALD. WOODS.

This meeting called at the request of County Commissioner Everett L. DeFoor to discuss city policy of requiring a permit from the Gordon County Health Department prior to installation of water meters outside the corporate limits of the city.

Commissioner DeFoor explained to Council that some residents of the county were delayed for as much as two weeks awaiting percolation tests. Mr. DeFoor stated further that the Health Department claimed to be overworked and this work could be removed from their work load and at the same time get a lot of people "off his back" because of the aforementioned delays.

Council decided that since this policy was instituted at the request of Mr. Richard Mitzelfelt of the health department and was of primary benefit to the county, the policy would be rescinded effective immediately. This was done on the motion of Ald. David and second of Ald. Holland.
